

## October 13, 2016 Marc Moret Winner of the Special Jury Prize at the Aerospace Awards 2016

Marc Moret, president of Loiretech, received from Patrick Longuet, Vice President of Assystem Aerospace, the special jury prize of the 2016 aeronautics trophy in Toulouse delivered by the newspaper La Tribune.

Several trophies corresponding to the following themes: Market adaptation, Factory of the future and Industrial Performance, Innovation, International, Digital and finally Manager of the year, are delivered to the leaders of the sector whose action in these areas was particularly significant on the previous year. The special jury prize is awarded within the nominated managers on all criteria.

Recent news of Loiretech was marked by the successful integration of the Nantes branch of ALLIO group that led to create, on a common brand LOIRETECH, one of the most important players in the aeronautics tooling sector in Europe.

True to its fundamentals as innovation and international development, the company took advantage of its new dimension to extend its scope in China, United States and Russia, where it has set up new sales offices.

Loiretech is also exploring diversification ways and is particularly interested in renewable energy market to which it devotes part of its R&D budgets for the development of new composite blade manufacturing technology.

Bought in late 2003 by its president, Marc Moret, Loiretech designs and manufactures molds and tooling for the aerospace, automotive and defence markets.

Loiretech has a staff of 140 employees on two sites in Nantes region and 1 site close to Montreal Canada. The sales in 2015 were €14 million and expected to grow to €16 million in 2016.
